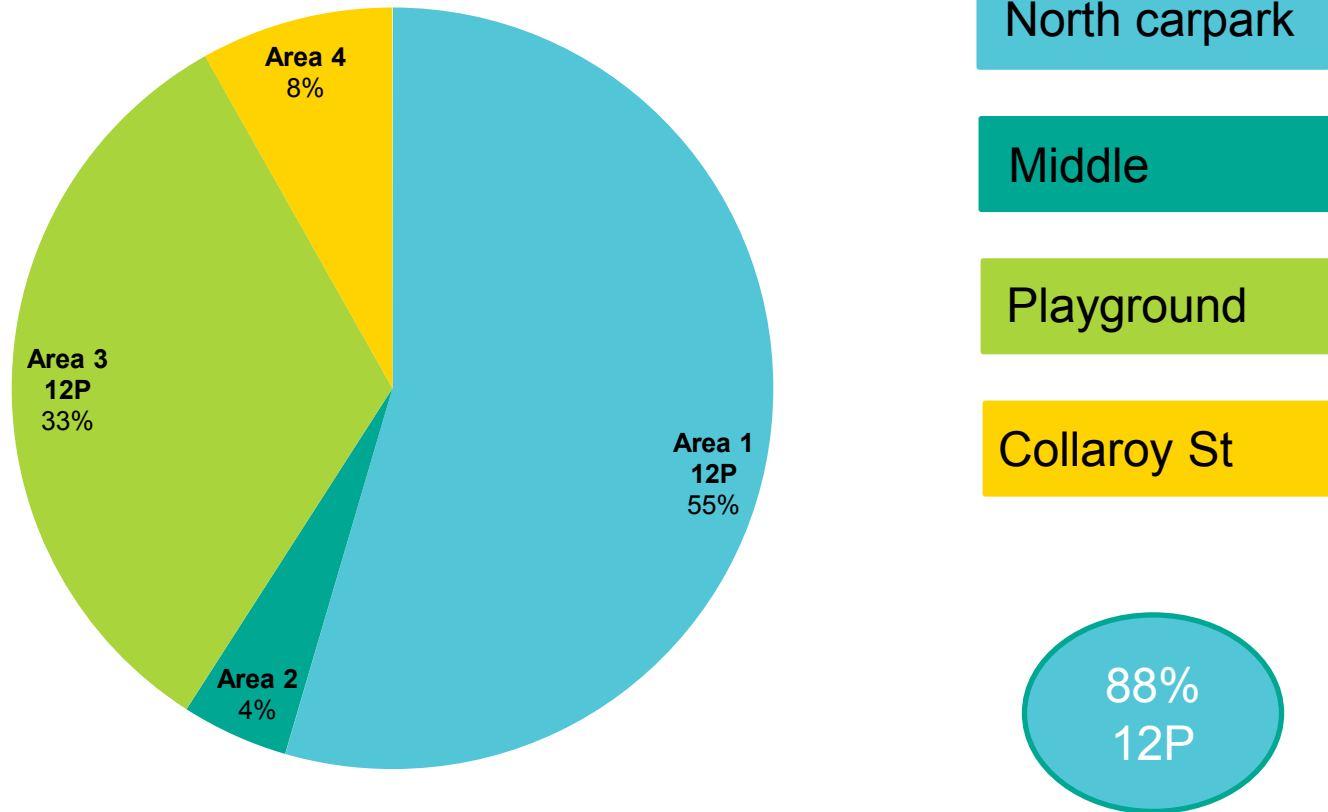

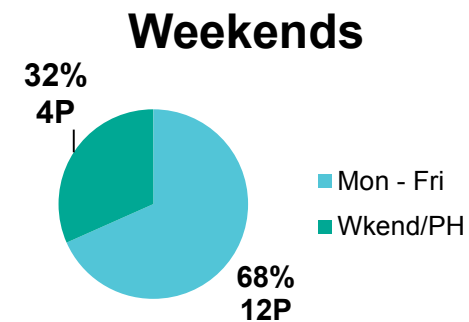

Revised Parking Supply

- 165 dedicated 12P spaces Monday to Friday
- Reduction from 192 to 165 12P spaces Monday to Friday (14%)
- 27 4P spaces to support the local area everyday
- 45 6P spaces weekends and public holidays

- Park in marked bays signs
- New gateway signs on carparks
- New parking signs in all carparks
- Motorcycle parking provided
