A flat site away from the coast surrounded by glass houses, a substation and houses. It adjoins the main road.

The layout is a grid pattern with a grassed central axis terminating in a steeply roofed shed.

The monuments are twentieth century, mainly included inscribed headstones. There are a number of impressive black granite monuments with headstones and carv^{ings} all in this highly polished material. The inscriptions are in gold lettering and the headstones in some include glass faced niches for candles and china roses.

There is a dark brick columbarium which shields the cemetery from the main road.

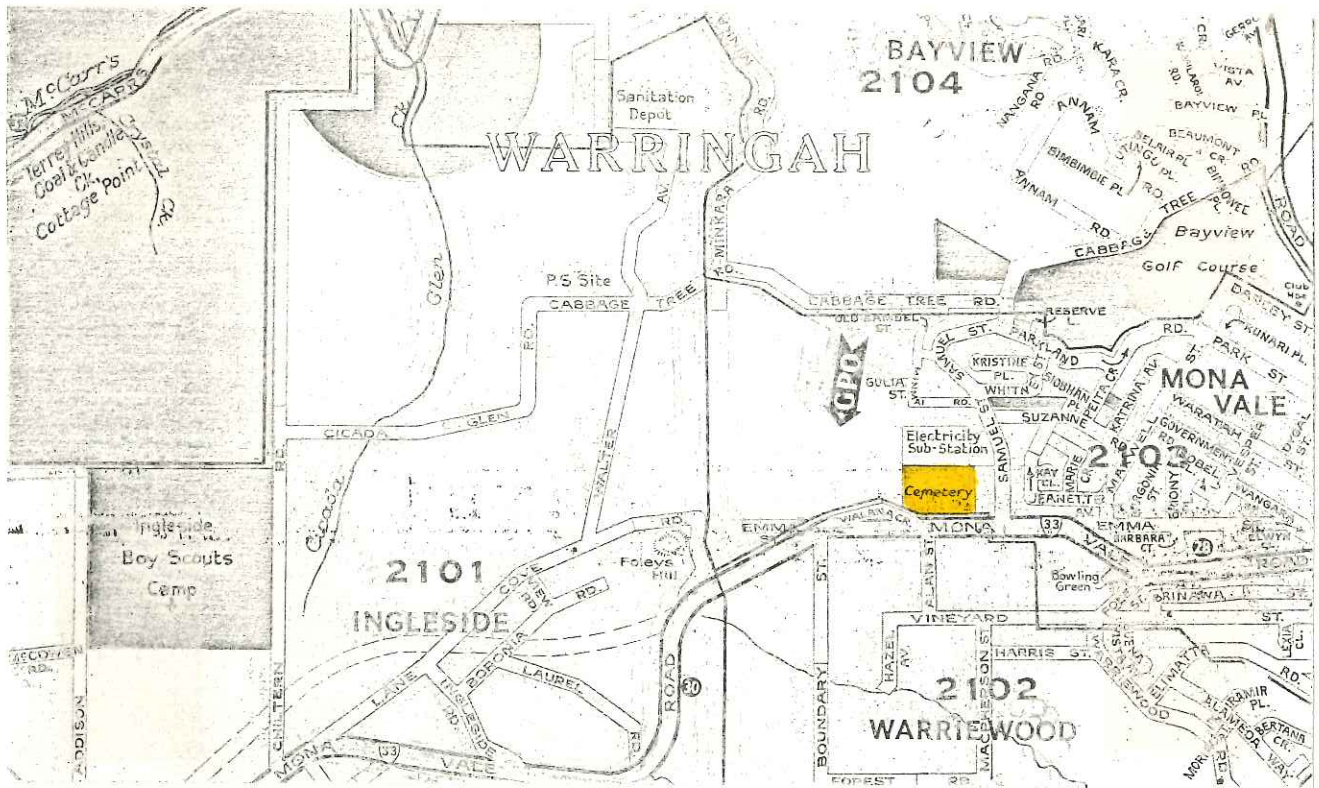
